Attendance Policy

- Full Year Course
 - Maximum of Seventeen (17) Absences
- 1 Semester Course (Half Year)
 - Maximum of Eight (8) Absences
- 3 Class Tardies = 1 Class unexcused absence

Important: Students who exceed these attendance limits may lose credit and be required to pay for and complete the course through Educere or repeat the course the following school year.

Credit Recovery Sessions

- Full Year Course
 - Absences 19 and 20
 - After School/Saturday detention
 - Take priority over extracurriculars
 - 21st Absence: Removal from class
- 1 Semester Course (Half Year)
 - Absences 10 and 11
 - After School/Saturday detention
 - Take priority over extracurriculars
 - 12th Absence: Removal from class

Verified vs. Unverified Absences

- 1A=Verified Absence
 - Parent/Guardian calls attendance office
 - No call goes home alerting you of student absence
 - No "Cuts"
 - Students can make up missed assignments and assessments
- 1=Unverified Absence
 - Parent/Guardian does not call attendance office
 - Call goes home alerting you of student absence
 - Possible "Cuts"
 - Zeros will be entered for missed assignments and assessments

Excused Absences

- Student illness supported by a written letter from a parent for 1 absence each occurrence. Two or more consecutive absences will require a written letter from a physician within five school days upon student's return to school.
- The student's required attendance in court
- The student's suspension from school
- Death of a family member for up to ten days per occurrence supported by notification to the school by the student's parent prior to the absence
- College visit(s), up to 3 days per school year for students in grades eleven and twelve
- Examination for a driver's license
- Take Our Children to Work Day
- Religious observance, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:36-14 through 16
- Participation in district board of election membership activities. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:36-33
- Closure of busing school district that prevents a student from having transportation to the receiving school
- An absence considered excused by the Commissioner of Education and/or a New Jersey Department of Education rule

Excused and Unexcused Absences

"Prolonged or repeated absences, excused or unexcused, from school or from class, deprive students of the educational and classroom experiences deemed essential to learning and may result in retention at grade level or loss of credit or removal from a course that would count toward the high school diploma in accordance with policies of this Board."

Tardiness

• 20 or more minutes late to period 1 classes=1 absence (8:05am)

- 10 or more minutes late to all other classes=1 absence
- Absences due to tardiness could be considered a class "cut"

• 3 Tardies=1 Absence

 - 3 Absences: Warning Letter Sent
 - 6 Absences: Warning Letter Sent
 - 10 Absences: Warning Letter Sent
 - 12 Absences: Attendance Contract
 - 15 Absences: Final Warning Letter Sent
 - 18 Absences: Loss of Credit Letter Sent and Mailed Home

*Parent portal is locked until parent/guardian verification form is completed.

 - One Semester Course:
 - 3 Absences: Warning Letter Sent
 - 5 Absences: Attendance Contract
 - 6 Absences: Warning Letter Sent
 - 9 Absences: Loss of Credit Letter Sent and Mailed Home

Impact on Transcript

Educere courses are graded pass/fail

Grades earned in these course do not impact GPA

Attendance Appeals

 Student must file a written appeal to Mr. Finizio within five (5) school days of receiving a loss of credit notice. This written appeal should state the reason for each absence and any documentation that supports these reasons.




